


What is Financial Responsibility?

Financial Responsibility is a formal acknowledgement that students agree to fulfill their financial obligations to the university. Students can review and update their annual agreement by clicking their Student Account checklist via <u>mypurdue.edu</u> and click the link *"Affirmation of Financial Responsibility"*. Doing so will automatically release the hold on your account. Lack of compliance will result in your inability to register for classes, including the ability to drop or add courses.

How to Complete your Financial Responsibility

• Click on Student Account Checklist.



Select "Affirmance of Financial Responsibility"

Student Account Checklist Please complete all tasks requiring action (marked with). Failure to complete these required tasks will impact your status. Note that some tasks require re-verification each semester or annually. Task Confirm Your Enrollment Affirmance of Financial Responsibility

- Once you have read the TaxPayer Identification Number section, you must choose one of the following three options:
 - 1. Enter your taxpayer identification number,
 - 2. Select you are a foreign national/non resident alien statement, or
 - 3. Select you do not wish to provide a taxpayer identification number.

After making your selection please completely read the Financial Obligation statement, enter your first name, last name, and last four digits of your PUID at the bottom to acknowledge
