

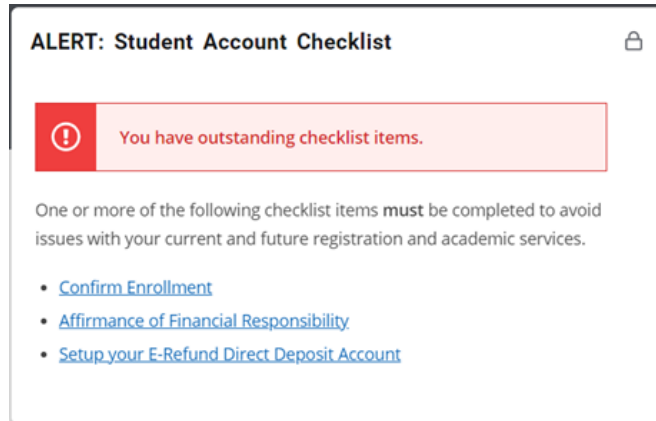


## What is Financial Responsibility?

Financial Responsibility is a formal acknowledgement that students agree to fulfill their financial obligations to the university. Students can review and update their annual agreement by clicking their Student Account checklist via [mypurdue.purdue.edu](http://mypurdue.purdue.edu) and click the link “*Affirmance of Financial Responsibility*”. Doing so will automatically release the hold on your account. Lack of compliance will result in your inability to register for classes, including the ability to drop or add courses.

## How to Complete your Financial Responsibility

- Click on Student Account Checklist.



- Select “Affirmance of Financial Responsibility”
